Public Input Hearings Regarding the Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority's (PWSA) Proposed Rate Increases

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) has scheduled two in-person and two telephonic public input hearings to gather information and hear from ratepayers regarding PWSA's proposed rate filing to increase water, wastewater conveyance, and stormwater services by \$146.1 million over three years..

The PUC is the state agency that is investigating the proposed rate changes and will make the final determination as to what increase, if any, is just and reasonable.

The Public Input Hearings will be held in person at 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 25, 2023 at the Jeron X. Grayson Community Center, (Media Room), 1852 Enoch Street Pittsburgh, PA 15219 and telephonically, at 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 27, 2023.
